

Build an energy-efficient home and get up to \$22,000 cash back!

Are you rebuilding a home that was destroyed by the 2003 Cedar, Paradise or Otay wildfires? Will your new or reconstructed residence be connected to the SDG&E grid?

If you answer **YES** to both questions, you are eligible to get cash back by participating in the Rebuild a Greener San Diego Program.

Program Offerings:

SOLAR PV PACKAGE

Get **\$4,000 per kilowatt per residence** for installing a solar electric (photovoltaic) system -- maximum of 5 kilowatt total system size (\$4,000 rebate x 5 kilowatt system = \$20,000).

ENERGY-EFFICIENCY PACKAGE

Lower your energy cost by using energy-efficient materials and installing energy-efficient equipment. Choose from one of the packages below and have your contractor follow the minimum equipment requirements to receive your rebate.

Package 1: \$1,700 cash rebate

QUALIFYING EQUIPMENT	MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS
Furnace	80% or greater AFUE gas-fired (natural or propane)
Air-Conditioner	12.0 or greater SEER
Dual-Pane Windows	0.4 U-factor or less and 0.4 SHGC or less
Water Heater	0.62 or greater energy-factor gas-fired (natural or propane)
Radiant Barrier	

Package 2: \$2,000 cash rebate

QUALIFYING EQUIPMENT	MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS
All of the measures in Package 1 plus	
Air-Conditioner Upgrade	Installation of Thermal Expansion Valve
Duct Upgrade	Application of ACCA Manual D to be verified by HERS rater.

The Rebuild a Greener San Diego Program is a partnership between the City of San Diego, County of San Diego, San Diego Regional Energy Office and San Diego Gas & Electric. The program was created to benefit residents who lost their homes in the October 2003 firestorms. Commercial, multifamily or accessory buildings that were destroyed in the October 2003 firestorm may also qualify for energy-efficiency or self-generation incentives under the program on a case-by-case basis.
