San Diego Police Department

For emergencies dial 911. For non-emergencies call 858-484-3154. If you see a homeless/migrant encampment please contact the SDPD. They provide a Homeless Outreach Team (HOT) together with the Psychiatric Emergency Response Team (PERT) and are the initial point of contact. For more information on HOT and PERT you can call 211, 24 hours a day 7 days a week.

Crime Mapping formerly Neighborhood eWatch

Crime Mapping is designed to automatically alert you via e-mail of recent crime activity in your selected neighborhood(s). This free subscription service will act as a "cyber" neighborhood watch. Sign up at www.crimemapping.com/subscriptions/subscribe.aspx.
