### **Ornamental Landscaping**

- Irrigation checks and repairs continue. For all irrigation systems that are on a slope or near a sidewalk, a purple washer is being added so run off is minimized. Irrigation systems are currently off due to the recent and on-going rainy weather.
- Myoporum pacificum (groundcover) has been removed in three planter beds at Butterfly Park. Compost has been placed down. The area will be planted once the soil begins to dry out, likely in early Spring.
- Myoporum parvifolium cuttings are being planted on slopes that have dead patches in the groundcover.
- Sticker removal continues to be removed from the back of traffic signs.
- Trash clean-up is scheduled to remove illegal dumps and trash down the canyon side on Spring Canyon Road.

### **Tree Trimming**

- Nine dead Eucalyptus have been removed by West Coast Arborists; three on Spring Canyon Road (across from Innovations Academy), one east of Dry Creek mini park (Spring Canyon Road), one on Scripps Ranch Boulevard, three on Scripps Poway Parkway and one on Blue Cypress Road.
- During the last storm two Eucalyptus trees fell; one on Scripps Poway Parkway and one on Spring Canyon Road.

### **Mini-Parks**

- Staff is working with Blueskies on cleaning the planter beds, removing dead plant material, adding mulch where needed, removing and transplanting plant material where it is appropriate, and redefining the landscape plan for the mini parks that resembles the original plant pallet.

## **Landscape Contract**

- Blue Skies continues to provide services within budget.
