Dear Mr. Wulfeck:

This is regarding the posted speed limit on Scripps Poway Parkway between Spring Canyon Rd. and City Limit in the community of Miramar Ranch North. Local governments must follow the procedures set by the State of California when setting speed limits on public streets. The California Speed Trap Law (California Vehicle Code Section 40802) requires that the City survey the prevailing speeds on classified streets every seven years in order to keep our speed limits radar enforceable under the provisions of the law.

We have recently surveyed the above segment of Scripps Poway Parkway and the results of the study indicate that the existing posted speed limit of 45 miles per hour for both the eastbound and westbound directions of traffic must be raised to 50 miles per hour in order to remain radar enforceable. Therefore, we will be changing the speed limit in both directions from 45 miles per hour to 50 miles per hour.
