Tree Trimming

- Butterfly Gardens Park had a fallen Pine Tree removed and replaced with two, 15 gallon Japanese White Pines. Several monument corners were trimmed due to sign blockage. The certified Arborist recommended that we remove four more trees that were in jeopardy of destroying private property, they will be replaced with a smaller species of tree.
