**STATEMENT SUPPORTING REASON FOR ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION:** The City of San Diego has concluded that the project as described above will not result in any impacts to the environment. The GPR study has already been conducted but the resulting data analysis must be completed in order to provide City staff and decision-makers with findings for how to proceed with the Citywide Trench Cut Study. The project meets the criteria set forth in State CEQA Guideline Section 15262 "Planning and Feasibility Studies" which can be used for projects or actions involving only feasibility or planning studies for possible future actions which the agency, board or commission has not approved, adopted or funded and does not require preparation of an EIR, but does require consideration of environmental factors.
