**Meeting Minutes:**

- I. Meeting called to order at 4:32 by Chair Jenny Cornelissen
  
- II. Approval of October minutes
  - Corrections: 7 committee meetings required each year (record says 6); Jerebek Principal is Angelia not Angelica Watkins
  - Gail Faber motions to approve minutes with corrections; Christina Liu seconds; Approved
  
- III. Area Superintendent Update by Monika Hazel
  - Update on Scripps Ranch schools test scores (see attached slides)
    - SR scores better than national and state averages, which showed loss during pandemic
    - On average most schools showed an increase in ELA scores in 2022 relative to 2018/2019 scores; math scores dipped slightly but less than 5%

## SRSC Meeting – November 16, 2022

- SR cluster doing well compared to La Jolla, outperforming at the MS/HS level and similar at the Elem level; SR cluster outperforming Mira Mesa cluster
- SRHS reports that ELA students struggled the most during the pandemic; supports are in place this year (extra classes, peer mentors) to help close the gap
- Jerabek and EBS both reported that scores for students with disabilities improved during pandemic thanks to extra supports that were put in place
- Schools are looking for discrepancies and opportunities for differentiation

- New Community STEAM lab and education space plans
  - Complex across from new Vons open to all SR schools. Will have classrooms with breakout spaces, makerspace, community meeting space, community garden
    - plan attached
  - Goal is to complete construction in spring; per Bob Ilko construction currently held up
  - Nothing firmly in place yet on how to use space; looking to bring in feedback from SRSC and area schools – create a subcommittee?
  - No information yet on staffing or transportation
  - Jill Halsey, Jerabek parent - starting thoughts: What is mission/vision? career/tech pathways? School level committees? Are there other sites that we can use as a model?
  - Ellen, MMS parent - should consider mentorship, leadership, equity considerations, ways to support first generation college students
  - Tamara Hurley - Could it be used as a wet lab space (e.g. STEAM around oceans or climate change)?

  - Targeting March or April, will send a poll to gauge preferences

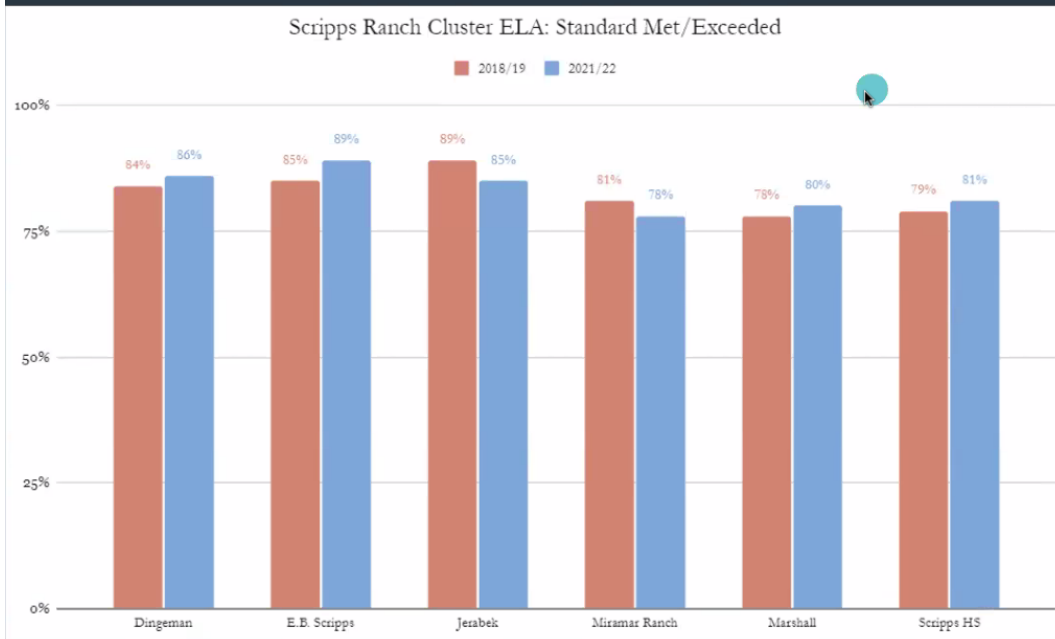

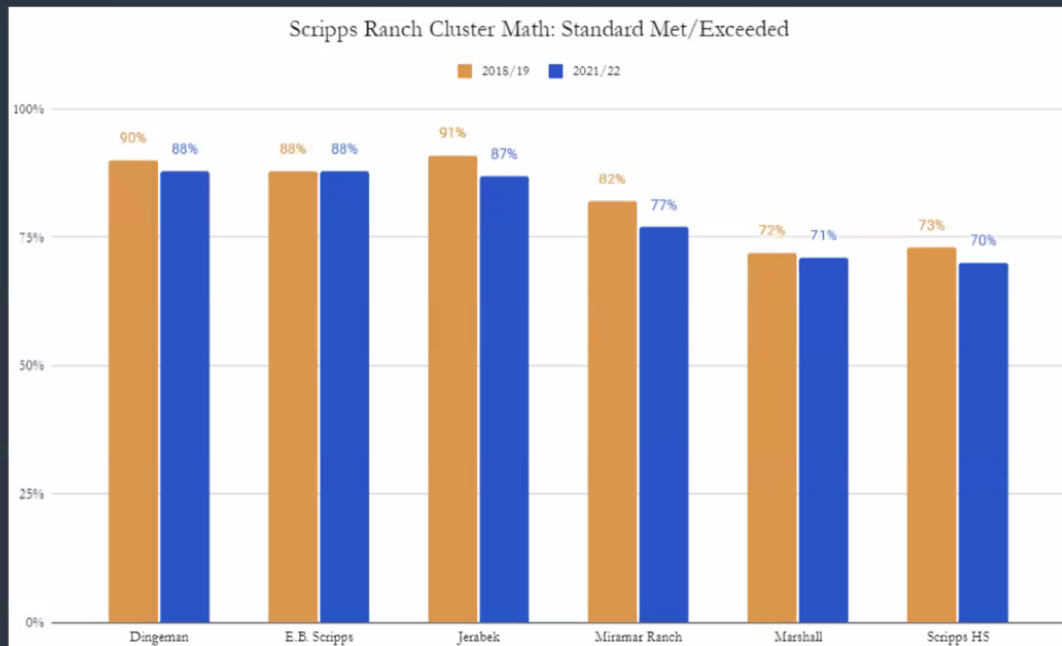
